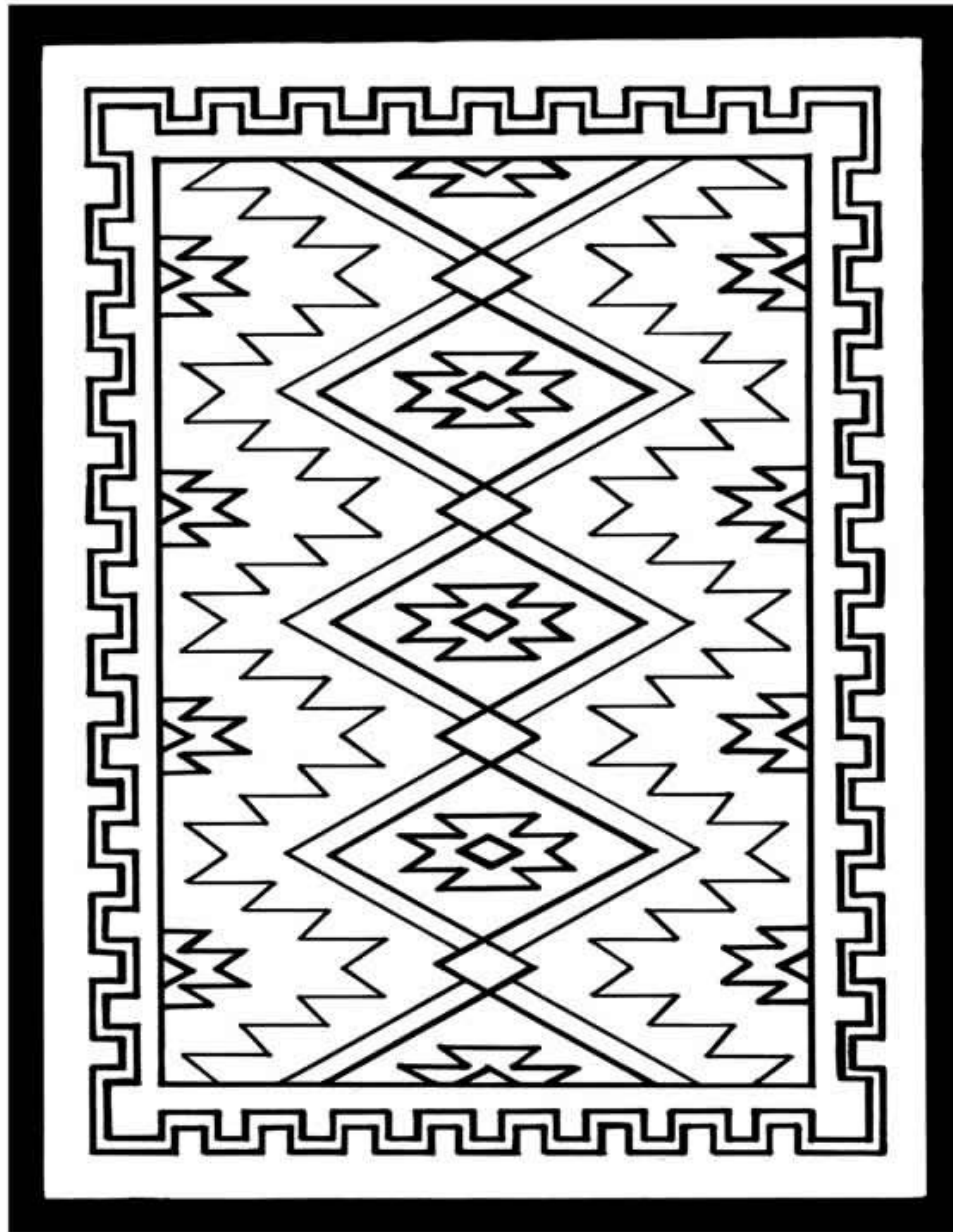

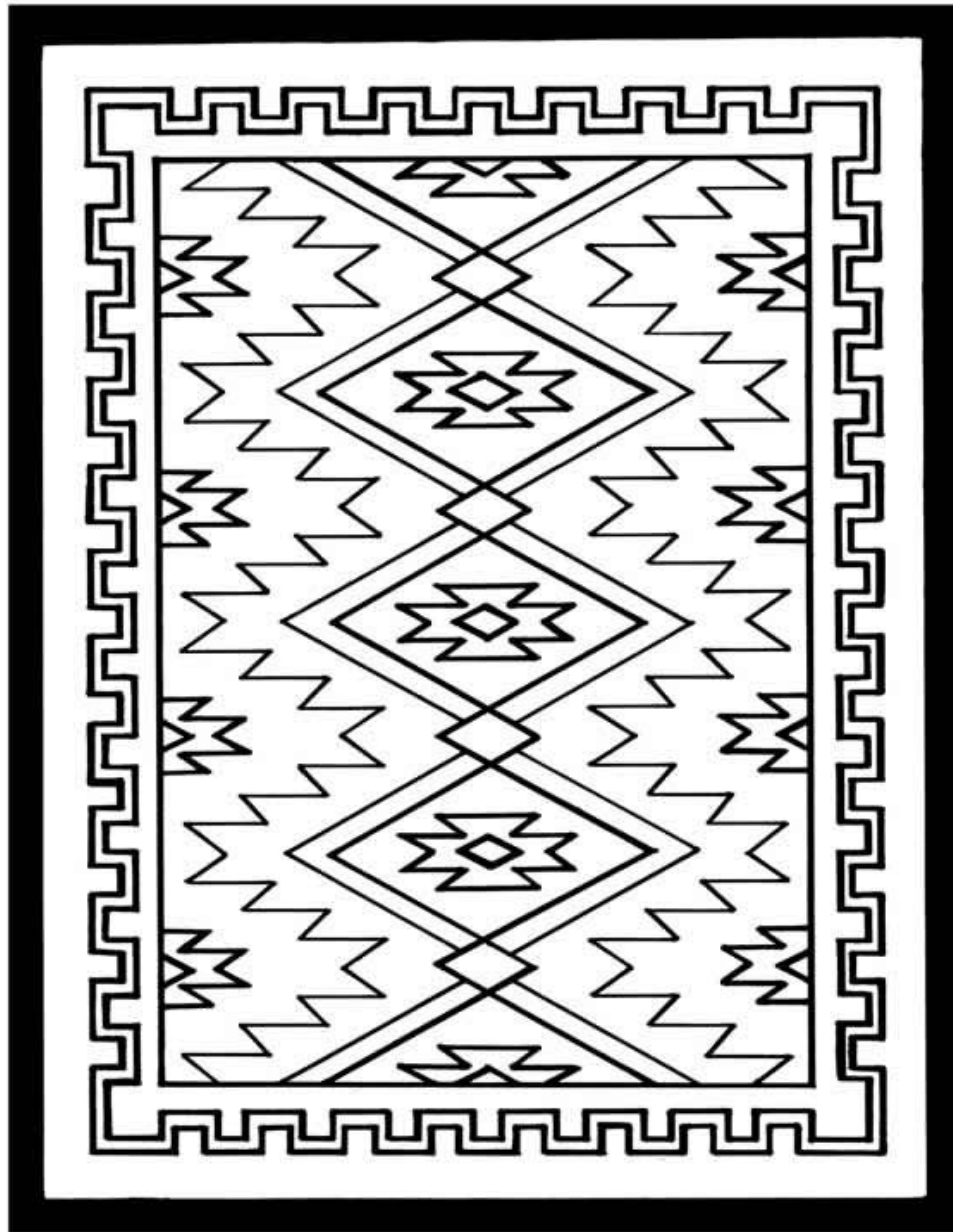

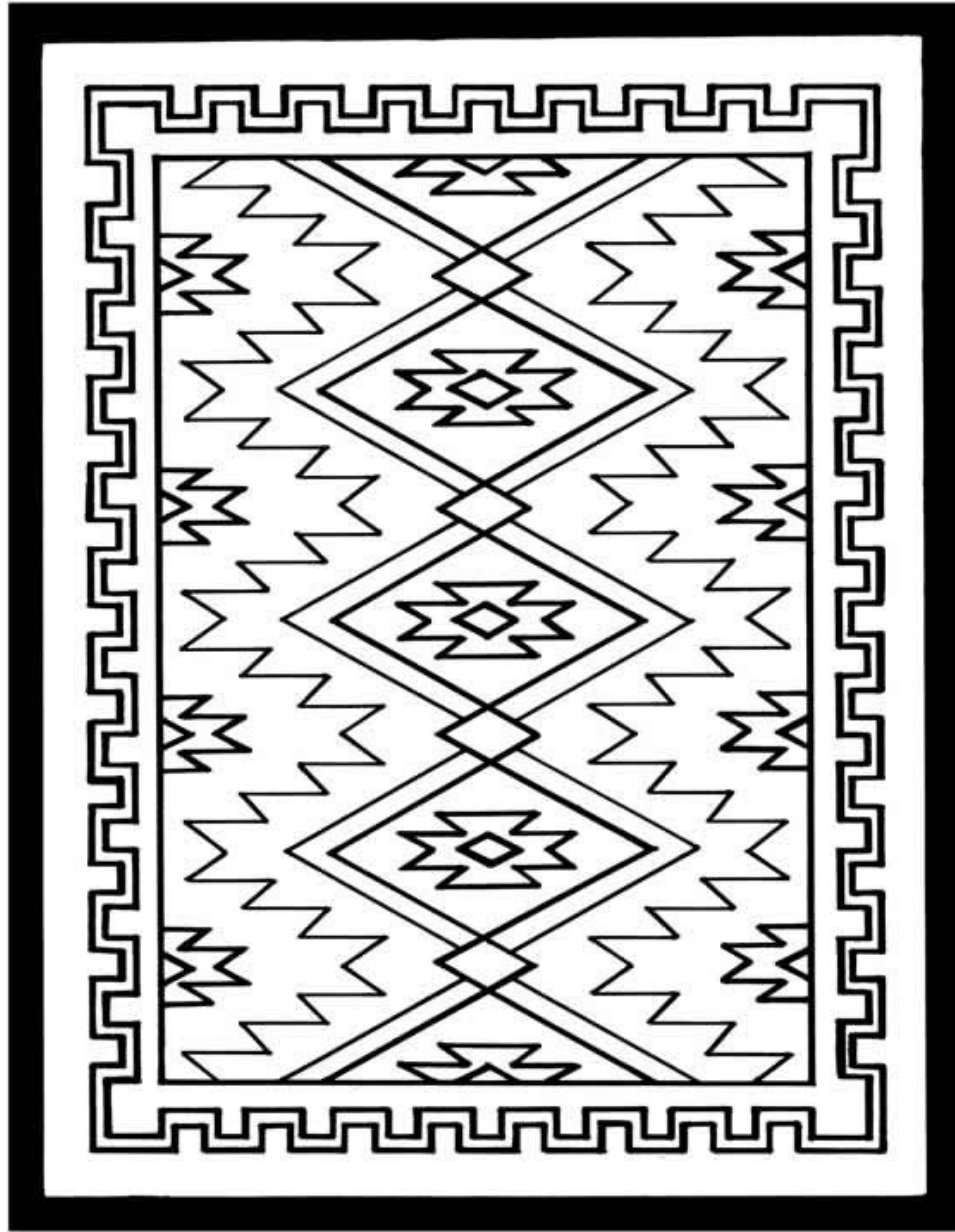

beautifully.



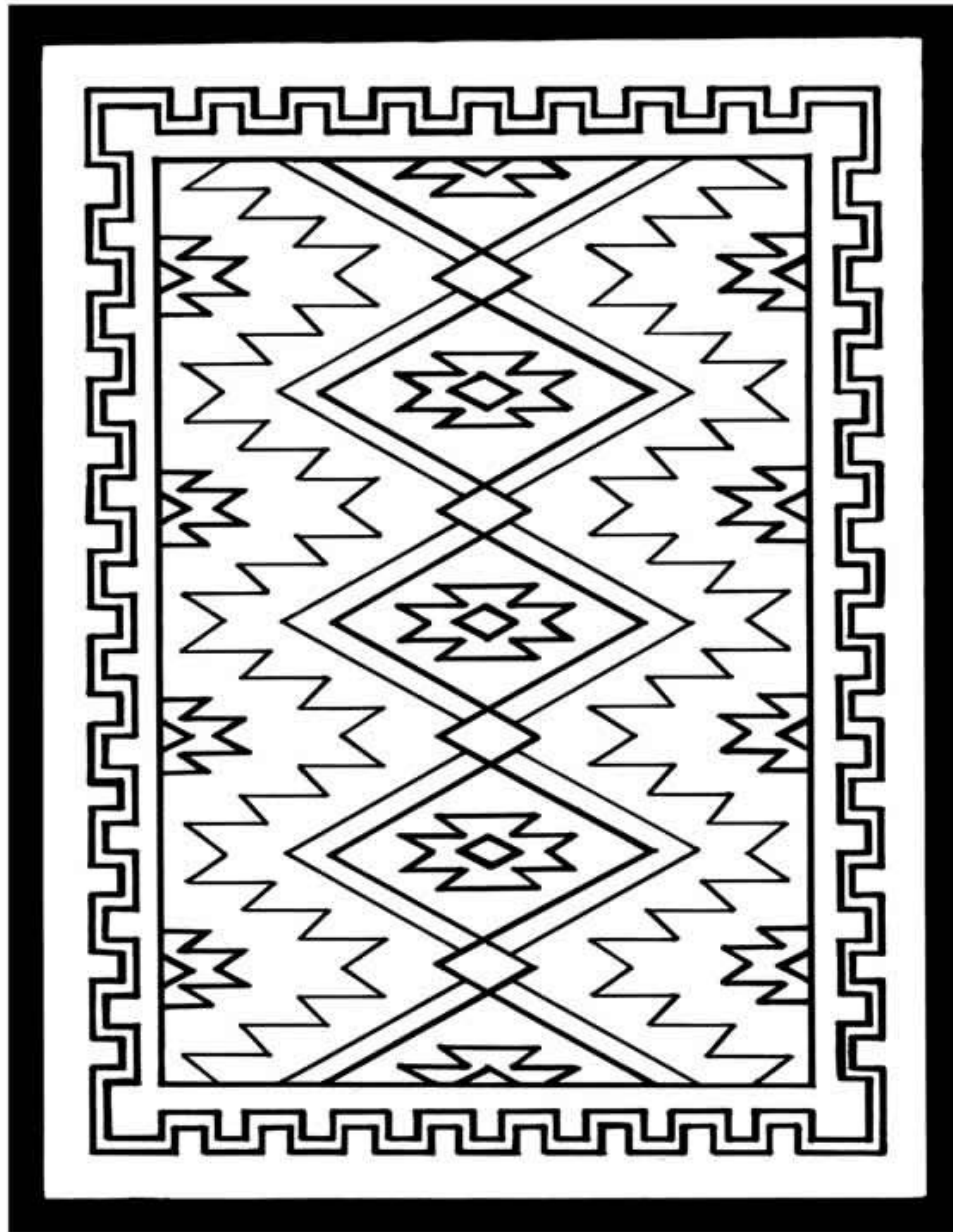

orange rug beautifully.

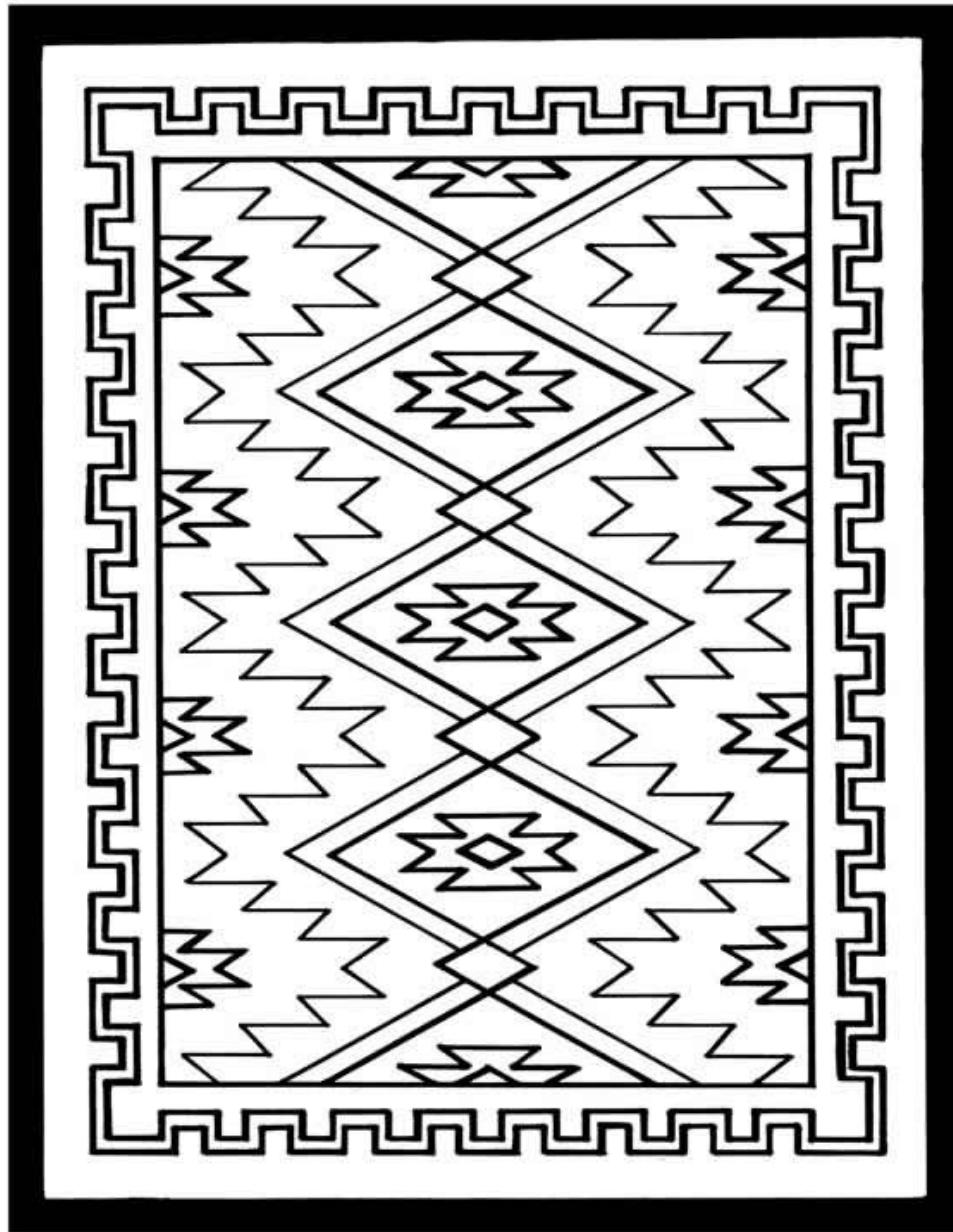


Shideezhí dǐi diyogí łitsooígíí

rug beautifully.

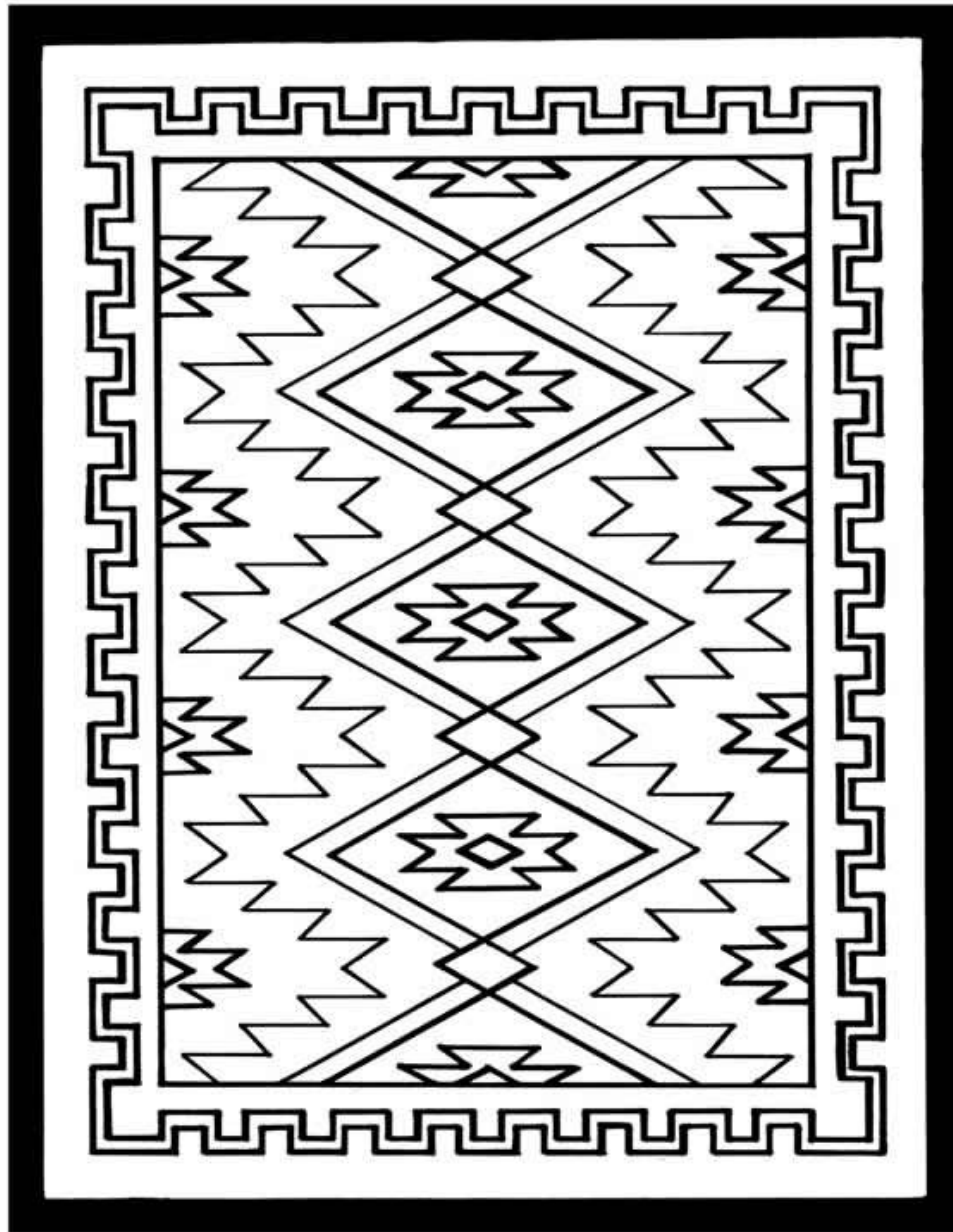

beautifully.



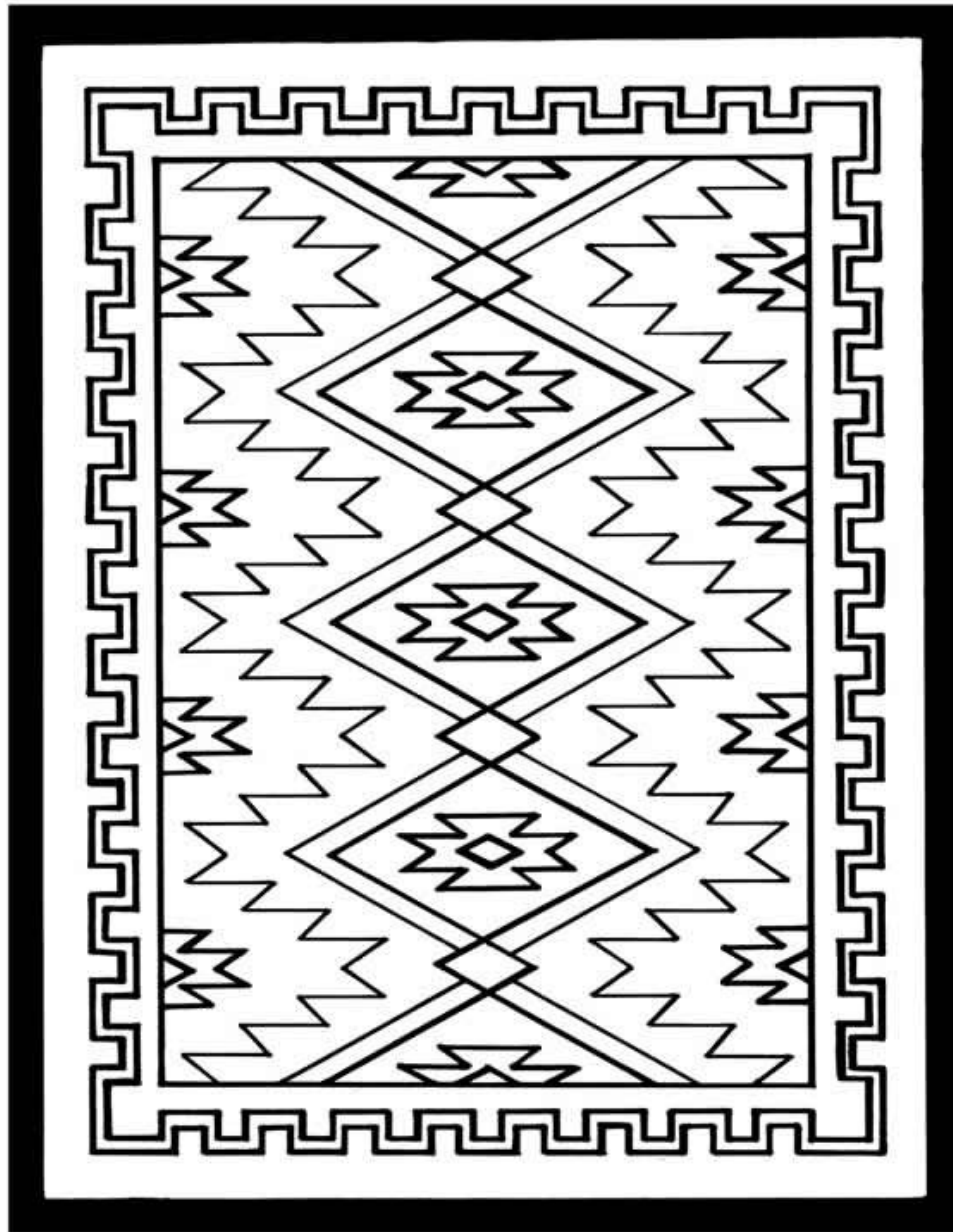

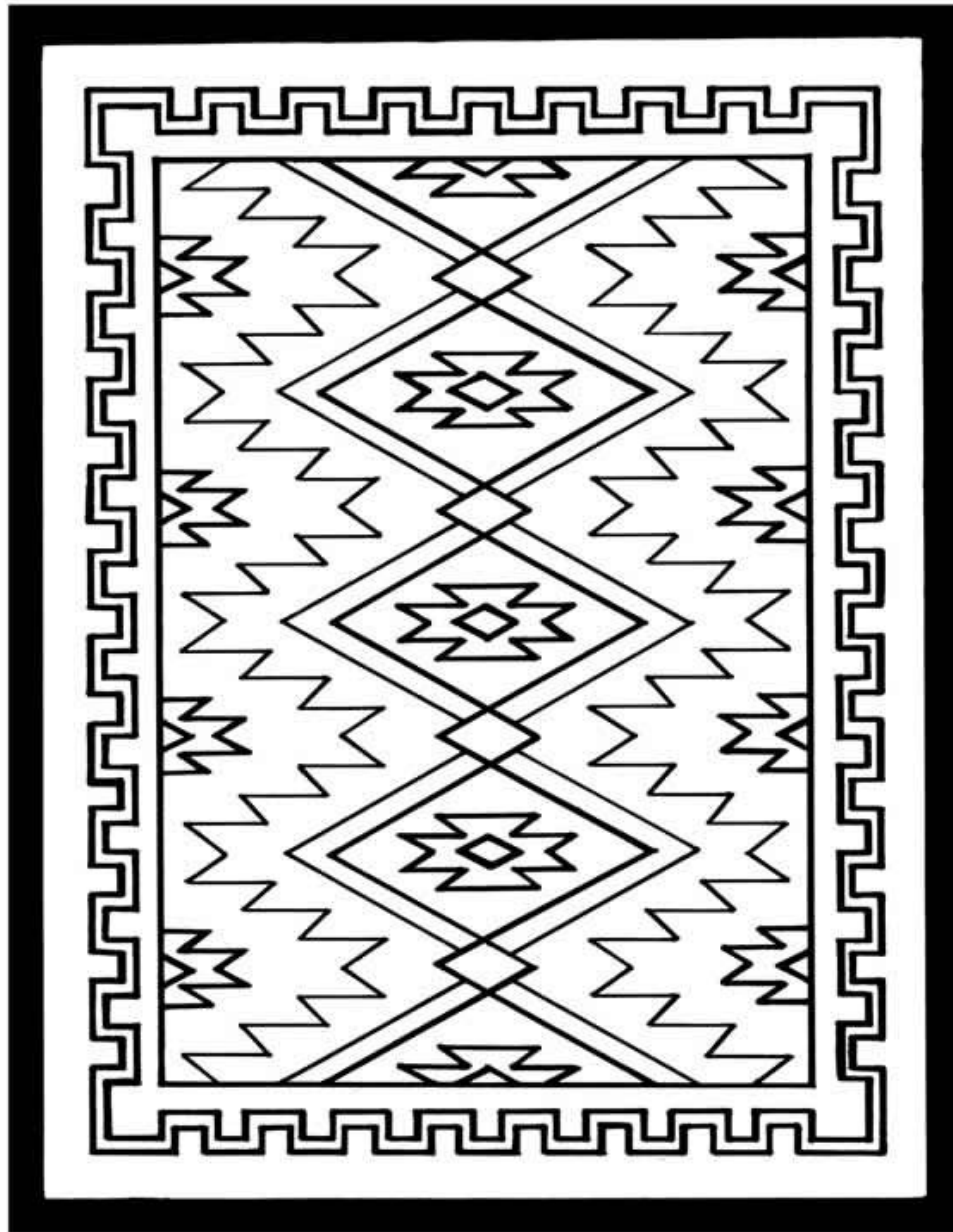
My paternal aunt made this purple

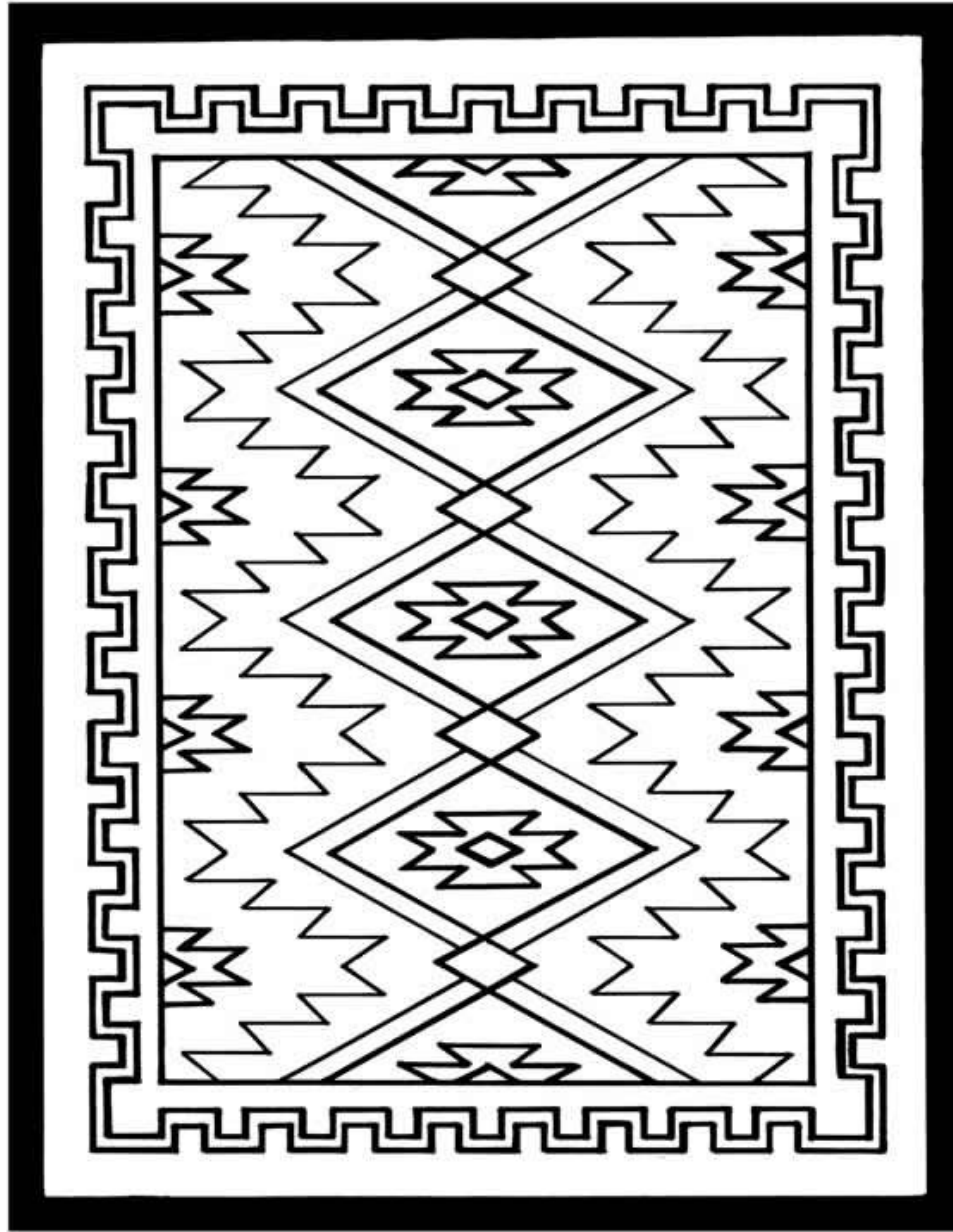
My paternal grandmother made this
